RV Reservations

The Specialty site will accommodate approximately 10 RV's (dependent on size and configuration) on a parking lot. There will be no on-site hook-ups (electrical, water, sanitary, etc) provided. Fresh water will be available in the dog wash area. Proper potable hoses must be used. If you do not have this hose, you may be provided with one from the RV Chair. We can schedule in a "Honey Wagon" dump service during the week for an additional fee that will be paid directly to the service provider. Please contact the RV chair early in the specialty week if this is desired.

RV attendees who are not registered into a resort guestroom will be charged \$35 plus tax (5.5%) per day for the rental of the parking space. RV attendees, who are registered into a guest resort room for their entire stay, will not be charged for parking privileges. People attending the specialty that will be in need of day parking for RV's must reserve with the RV chairperson, also. RV's may arrive no earlier than May 8, 2005 and must depart by the end of the day May 15, 2005. Reservations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Transportation

HERDING - Deadline April 12th

The AKC Herding Test & Trial will be held on Monday, May 9th at the High Reach Farm in Hampshire, Illinois. It is approximately 45-60 minutes from Lake Lawn Resort. Entries are limited to 50 runs. Entries to be filled in order received. An alternate list will be developed as well. Herding Trial/Test entries are \$40 per dog for Sheep and \$30 per dog for Ducks. Sheep stock will be 5 head per run: Crossbred Sheep (Barbados/Khatadin). Duck stock are English Call Ducks (various Colors). The BSCA HIC's will be offered on Thursday, May 12th at Lake Lawn Resort. HICs limited to 25 per judge. There will be a random draw with an alternate list if all 50 slots fill. HIC runs will have 3 sheep (same flock as test/trial). HIC entry is \$30 per dog. TRACKING - Deadline April 13th

The **Tracking TD** and **TDX** test will be held early morning Wednesday, May 11th at the Ottawa Dog Trial Grounds in Eagle, WI (45-60 minutes North of the Host Hotel). Limit is 6 TD tracks and 3 TDX tracks and will be open to Belgian Sheepdog only. If the TD or TDX does not fill, track(s) may be substituted in one or the other test.

Situated in the Kettle Moraine Forest, the Ottawa Dog Trial Grounds has many advantages to offer our tracking enthusiasts including a large shelter with a covered picnic area is positioned to allow spectators an excellent view of some of the tracks and mowed paths allowing easy access to various fields. Ground cover varies greatly, however, from lush, thick, knee-high grass to sparse cover on sandy soil. The sand-based soil throughout the site offers excellent drainage in the event of inclement weather and there is very little chance of flooding. A wide variety of TDX obstacles exist at the Dog Trial Grounds, including, but not limited to, downed trees, woods, ravines, and steep hills.

The Ottawa Dog Trial Grounds is a "fee" site, being a part of the Wisconsin State Forest. Exhibitors and spectators will have to pay \$5.00/day per vehicle for Wisconsin residents; \$10/day per vehicle for out of state visitors. Fees are subject to change and are payable at the site. For all Tests, Bitches in season may participate, in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. The Tracking Chair is Terri Votava at sansbranco@alltel.net.

- 6) State whether the ad is camera ready or to be used as a guide. Camera ready art is scanned in. Most times it cannot be changed in any way with the exception of adding a photo. If you have a spelling error, it will appear with it.
- 7) A camera ad should preferably be done with a laser printer. Inkjet printers may or may not qualify; if done with an inkjet printer, the ad must be printed on inkjet paper.
- 8) You may also submit your ad on a disk. For more info on compatible file formats, email pasteup@onofrio.com.

10) I will be more than happy to try and group your ads with your breeders or something similar. Please let me know when you send them in, or better yet, send them all together in the order you want them. If you want certain pages facing each other, please note that also.

POLICY ON STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR BY ALL EXHIBITORS ATTENDING NATIONAL (AND OTHER) SPECIALTY SHOWS

The BSCA has an excellent history of maintaining its Specialty headquarters and show site in good condition. Rings, grooming areas and hotel rooms occupied by its members are expected to be left with no appreciable damage, and as clean as possible, after the Specialty is over. As a measure of insuring that this standard will be met, the Club, as a matter of policy sets forth the following standards of behavior:

1. No dog should be left uncrated in a hotel room in the absence of the occupants at any time.
2. Dogs that constitute a nuisance to other occupants of the hotel by continual barking or howling, may subject their owners to being removed by the hotel.
3. There will be no extensive grooming of dogs in the hotel rooms. Grooming will be permitted only in the areas set aside for that purpose.
4. No dogs should be washed in hotel bathtubs, and hotel towels should not be used on dogs for drying them or any other purpose. Outside bathing facilities with warm water and towels will be provided at the hotel. Tables and power will be available with a dryer that can be checked out from the hospitality room.
5. The external and internal premises of the hotel and show site shall be kept free of debris and feces caused by the presence of dogs attending the Specialty.
6. The BSCA urges its members to carefully inspect their rooms prior to checkout.
7. Exhibitors are not to bring litters of puppies to the Show Headquarters.
8. All dogs will be on a leash at all times.
9. Exercise pens are allowed only in the designated areas. Dogs may not be left unattended. Unattended or barking dogs will result in denial of further use of exercise pens for the remainder of specialty or removal from the host hotel.
10. It is important that everyone attending the specialty should strictly adhere to the designated dog exercise areas. There are numerous Native American burial grounds at the host hotel that are prohibited from person and dog traffic. The areas will be clearly marked. The golf course is also a prohibited area for dog traffic.
11. By exhibiting at the National Specialty, you are agreeing to abide by the rules established by the show committee and the host hotel. Failure to follow these rules will result in removal from the host hotel.

OTHER THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Climate** May in Wisconsin can bring just about any kind of weather imaginable, but typically temperatures range from the mid-60's to mid-70's. It can change from cool and damp to hot and sunny in the blink of an eye and the possibility of rain and/or thunderstorms exists. May is also the prime season for ticks, so come prepared for anything!
- Dog food** Many major brands of dog food can be purchased locally from Horse and Hound (3 miles east of the hotel on Hwy 50) or the Pet Depot (5 miles north on I-43, exit Hwy NN Elkhorn – ½ mile west towards Elkhorn).
- Grooming** Please do all you can to uphold the BSCA's excellent reputation for standards of conduct at your hotel and refrain from grooming in your room. A grooming area with power will be provided. Warm water, booster tubs, towels, power, and dryer will be available.
- Volunteers** Volunteers are needed for all events and committees. Offer your services by signing up on the Volunteer Form.
